Why we use your personal data

We collect personal data in order to:

- keep in touch with our members
- facilitate the running of tours
- to process payments for membership, goods, tours and donations
- maintain our website
- enrich the historical knowledge of the Dennistoun Conservation Area

Our legal basis for using your personal data

For most of the purposes above, we process personal data on the basis of our legitimate interests as an organisation. Our legitimate interests are to promote, maintain to educate and engage the public about the history of the Dennistoun Conservation Area.

For membership or the purchase of goods, we process personal data for the purposes of entering into and carrying out a contract with you.

We ensure that the personal data we collect is necessary for these purposes.

Rights

You have the right to request access to your personal data, to have your personal data corrected if it is incorrect and under certain circumstances to have your data removed or to request we stop processing it.
